Vantage Pointe Pool Rules

The pool is available to all members in good standing. The pool opens at 6:00 AM and closes at 9:00 PM to members 18 and under. After 9:00PM, only adult members are allowed unless children are accompanied by their parents. The pool closes at 11:00 PM for everyone. The Board has adopted an adult swim time on Tuesday and Thursday nights from 9-11 PM. No one under 18 is permitted. All persons found in violation of the approved hours will be subject to prosecution for trespassing. We are in compliance with requirements for immediate arrest. Members are encouraged to contact the Durham Police by dialing 911 if they see unauthorized use of the pool.

When in the pool or the pool area, please use good judgment and remember that others want to use the pool. All members and their guests swim at their own risk, owners and management are not responsible for accidents or injuries. Management reserves the right to deny use of the pool to anyone at anytime. The Durham County Health Department rules and recommendations concerning swimming pools and related facilities govern the health and safety rules of this pool. It is a Durham County Regulation that the gate be closed at all times for safety reasons, DO NOT PROP THE GATE OPEN.

- 1. Only appropriate bathing attire should be worn in the pool. (No street clothes)
- 2. Everyone must take a shower before entering pool, especially after applying oil or lotion.
- 3. Any person with an infection, skin abrasion, inflamed eyes, wearing bandages, or having a cold or cough may be denied use of the pool.
- 4. Members children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (minimum 18 years old) at all times.
- 5. Parents should encourage children to use the restroom before entering the pool.
- 6. Children who are not toilet trained should wear diaper and rubber pants and swimsuit in the pool.
- 7. All guests must be accompanied by sponsoring member at all times, who will be responsible for ALL activities of their guests. One guest per member allowed for members 18 and under; up to 10 guests for members 19 and over. 11 guests or over constitute a pool party and rule #8 must be followed.
- 8. Use of the pool for parties requires notifying management of the party and the posting of a notice one week in advance of the party. Parties are limited to 2 hours, and the pool cannot be closed to members. Members are responsible for all cleanup immediately following the party.
- 9. Running, pushing, wrestling, dunking, and diving are **NOT** allowed.
- 10. Bicycles, skates, skateboards and animals are **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN** in the pool areas.
- 11. **NO** eating and drinking within 5 feet of pool. **NO** chewing gum allowed in the pool area. **NO** smoking within 5 feet of the pool. Cigarettes should be extinguished in ash trays.

- 12. NO GLASS CONTAINERS ARE ALLOWED IN THE POOL AREA. SHOULD ANY GLASS BE BROKEN WITHIN THE POOL AREA, THE POOL WILL BE CLOSED AND DRAINED AS MANDATED BY LAW. FURTHER, THE MEMBER(S) RESPONSIBLE FOR THE BREAKAGE WILL BE ASSESSED THE FULL COST OF REPAIRING AND REFILLING THE POOL.
- 13. Trash and recyclables should be placed in the proper containers.
- 14. Everyone using the restroom and bathhouse is responsible for seeing they be kept clean.
- 15. PROFANE LANGUAGE, MUSIC, AND ROWDY BEHAVIOR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
- 16. Adults should not swim alone, and are not permitted if under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 17. The Board has established a "Quiet Time" before 10AM and after 9PM. No music or loud noises are permitted at all out of courtesy to the surrounding homeowners, appropriate disciplinary action will be taken if caught in violation of this.
- 18. Please do not hang on pool ropes, they are there for your protection.
- 19. Please respect those that are using the lap lane.
- 20. DO NOT PROP THE GATE OPEN, IT IS A DURHAM COUNTY REQUIREMENT FOR SAFETY REASONS.

VIOLATIONS FOR NOT ADHERING TO THESE RULES.

The Board of Directors have established the following penalties for violating the posted rules.

First offense - warning Second offense - suspend pool privileges for 2 weeks Third offense - suspend pool privileges for 2 months any further offenses will be suspensions for 60 days
